

Login Guide: PIONEER+ Online-Workshops

All external users can create an account for the PIONEER+-Online-Workshops in just a few clicks. All you need is a valid email address and a password. The registration process is described in detail below.

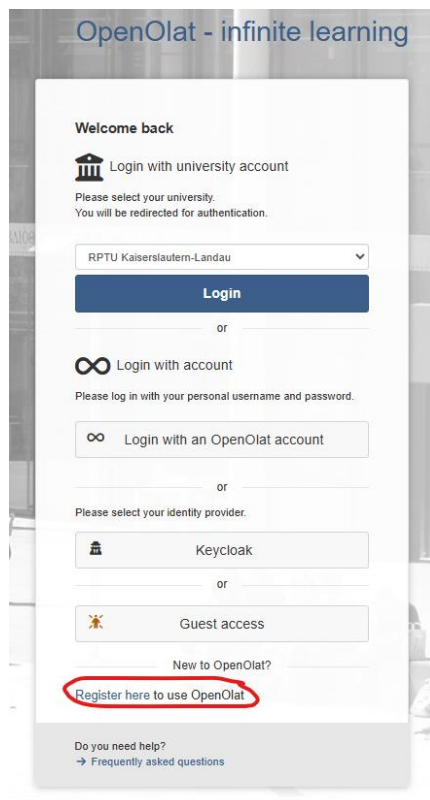
Step 1: Open OpenOLAT

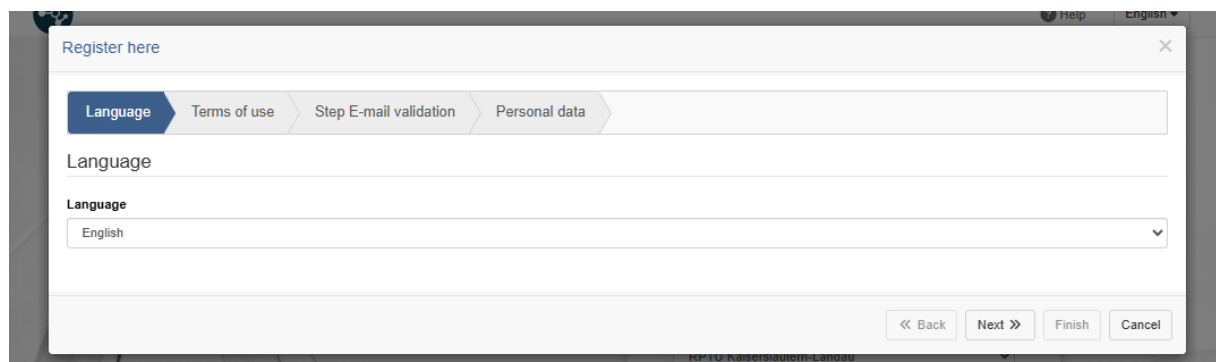
Step 2: OpenOLAT registration

Start the OpenOLAT registration process with the button „Register here to use OpenOLAT“:

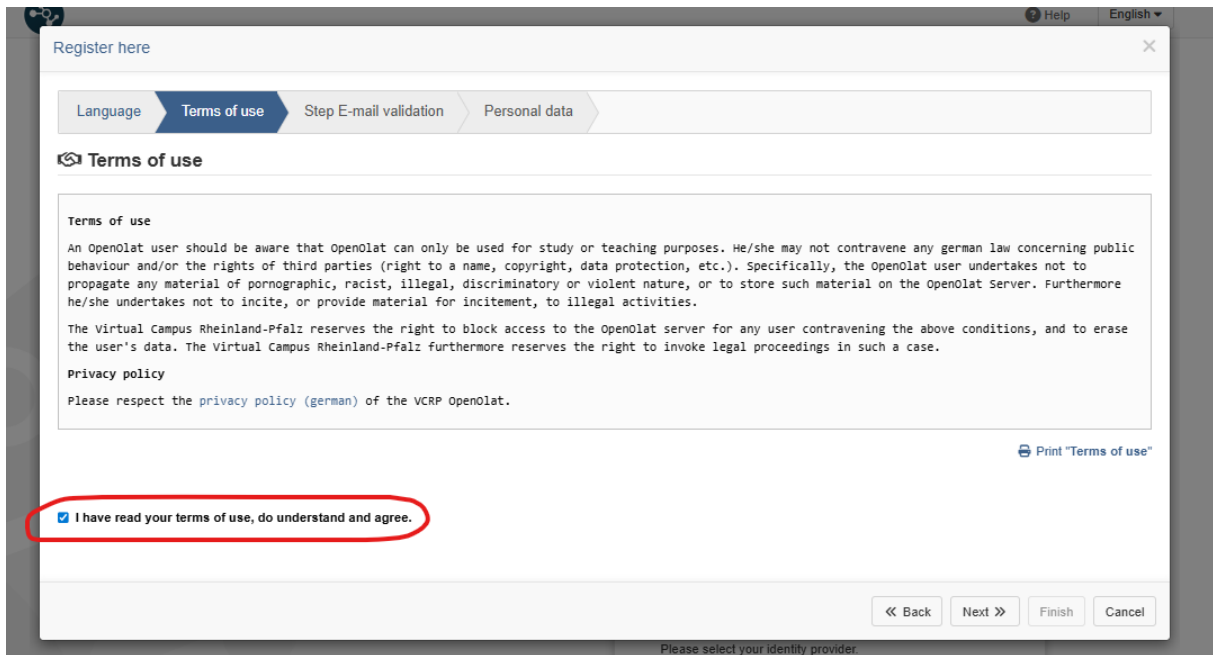
Step 3: Select Language

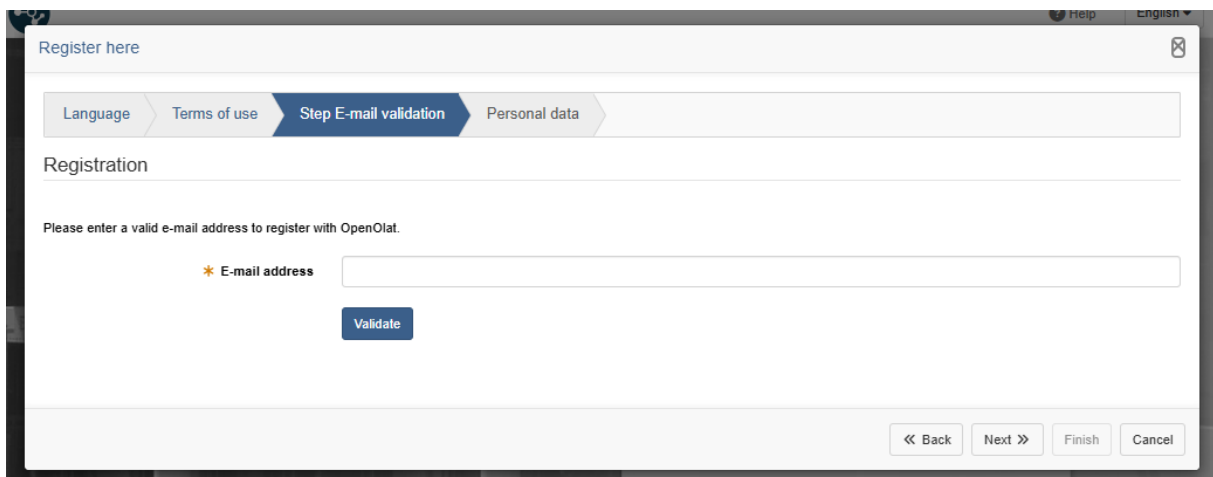
